On Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, the meeting started at 9:00 am with the participants' inscription and praying thanking God for a new day.

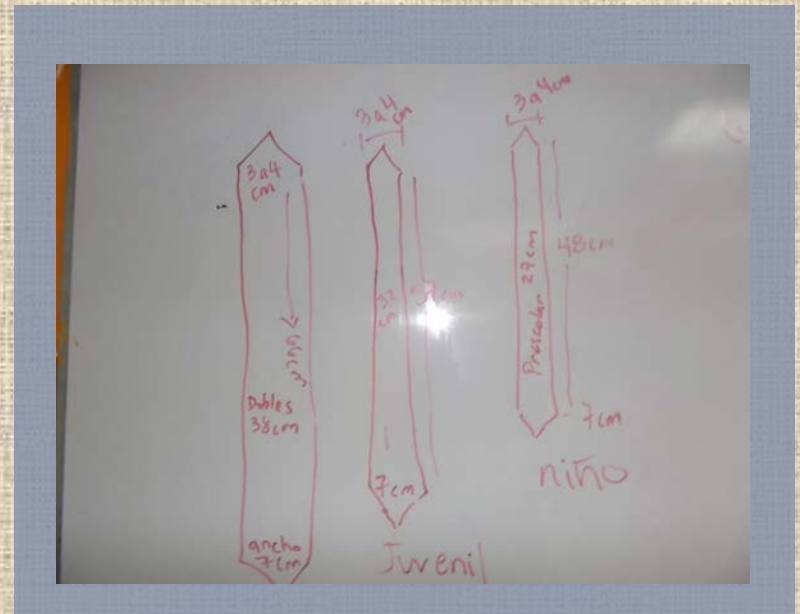
