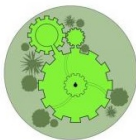
**Special thank you from the people burned in the December fire at Huembes Market in Managua.**

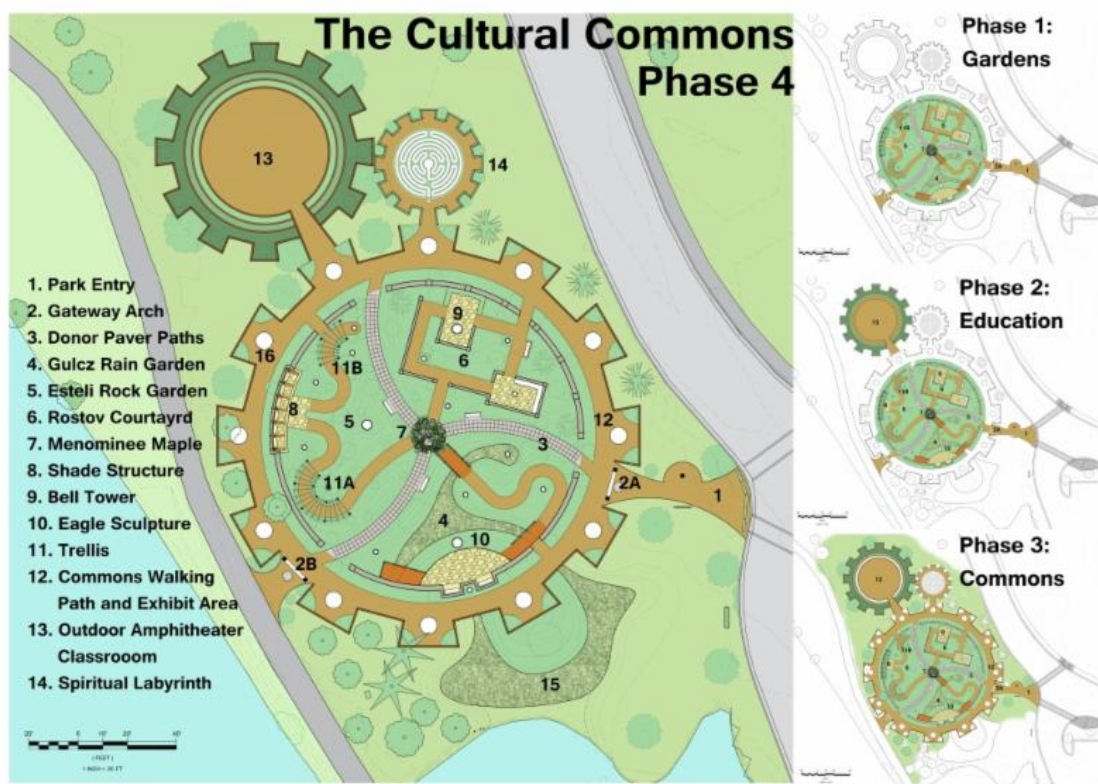
