I am very happy to care for children who visit the library. I work with 50 children on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3-5 pm. In those hours, we read and analyze reading because they like to read stories in family. It is noteworthy that our library is named "SHERIN Bowen" in honor of one of the founders of this organization who is well remembered for the great work that she performed for many years.



I like to keep the books well organized. I keep track of the books that we lend children to bring home. I make sure they are not in bad condition or damaged as it is important to take care of them because through them we learn to develop ourselves as people and professionals. Each member of this Library has its own ID to take and change the books after they have read them. Currently, we have an inventory of about 600 books including science, mathematics, Spanish, stories and novels.

This library is important for children and young people because they can do their school research, make crafts and learn cooking with the help of the organization and volunteers who help provide the necessary materials to do so.

With the pastry classes that we have been developing, we have seen much interest from children in participating and learning. They feel very happy and grateful to the people who make this training possible. It is another reason to keep helping and learning with the satisfaction of they can depend on themselves in the future to help the economy of their homes. I would like the organization to continue supporting this kind of learning in children in order to be an inspiration to them.



We need learning material such as books to dramatize, poetry books, and wooden puzzles to develop skills. Reading sessions, crafts, painting and pastries are basic components of much interest among children and it would be great if we can promote them.
